

Process for determining awards to beneficiary groups in February 2016

There were a total of 12 applications from potential beneficiaries amounting to c. £9,000 for an available fund of £5,000.

Due consideration was given to each project submitted to satisfy the trustees that the public benefit would be met and that the project would meet our charitable objectives.

Each application was scored on the basis of the organisation's need, contribution to the 2015 Street Fair, impact an award would have on total project funding requirement and sustainability of the project once completed.

Each trustee submitted their own scoring sheet and each beneficiary's total score has been divided by the number of trustees eligible to score that beneficiary to determine an average score. The beneficiaries were then ranked by their average score and the awards agreed on the basis of 100% to top four; 50% to middle four; £200 to bottom four.

Any trustee who has expressed a conflict of interest regarding a beneficiary was disqualified from scoring that organisation's bid.
