

#### Structure, Governance and Management

The charity's governing document is a Constitution adopted and signed by six Trustees at a meeting on 26<sup>th</sup> March 2015. An amendment to introduce a maximum of 11 (eleven) Trustees was approved by at least a 75% majority at the Annual General Meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2016.

Each Trustee has been nominated by another resident or property owner of Milton Abbas and signed a declaration that they were willing to stand as a Trustee and that they understood the Trust's purposes and rules as set out in the Constitution. At the 1<sup>st</sup> AGM, in accordance with our Constitution, all Trustees retired and were then elected by the Members.

Trustees Isherwood and Robinson have, as members of the Organising Committee, represented its interests at Trustee meetings.

Three (3) existing Trustees (Nigel Hodder, Christopher Skinner and Susan Woodhouse) will retire at the Annual General Meeting to be held on 26<sup>th</sup> April 2017 in accordance with the Constitution. Mr Hodder & Mrs Woodhouse are willing to stand for re-election at the forthcoming AGM. Mr Skinner has advised he will be resigning his position and will not be seeking re-election.

Confirmation from the Charity Commission that the Trust was recognised as a charity and entered onto their Register of Charities was received on 24<sup>th</sup> June 2015.

#### **Objectives and Activities**

The objects of the Trust are to advance such charitable purposes (according to the law of England and Wales) as the trustees see fit from time to time primarily for the benefit of the inhabitants of the Parish of Milton Abbas and its surrounds.

There being no Street Fair held since the last report, the only activity has been the planning by the Organising Committee of the forthcoming Street Fair to be held on Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> July 2017.

#### Achievements and Performance

Provisional awards were announced for 23 beneficiaries subject to the 2017 Street Fair achieving a surplus.

Dorset & Somerset Air Ambulance will be the nominated external charity following an agreement in a Members' vote in November 2016.

#### **Financial Review**

As the Street Fair is a biennial event, this financial year with no Fair taking place meant activity was fairly quiet.

The 2017 Fair's Accounts opened with a balance of £3,024; Gift Aid of £2,595 was received in April 2016 and with income over the year mainly derived from Stallholder Bookings, the closing balance was £12,367.

The use of Online Banking was introduced following agreement by the Trustees and this has already streamlined some transactions and will simplify many at the time of the Fair. Funds held in the Current Account were transferred to the Business Reserve to gain Interest but as the income was negligible and transfers required further reconciliation, the plan is to discontinue this action.

The costs of running the 2017 Fair look set to increase but it is hoped to contain the budget to a maximum of £20,000 and to make a profit to enable the distribution to Beneficiaries of the provisional grants of £19,475 agreed by the Trustees in October 2016. Additionally a donation is planned for our nominated external charity, Dorset and Somerset Air Ambulance.

At the AGM in July 2016, the members agreed to the re-appointment of Jennifer Tempier as Independent Examiner and the Accounts were duly examined by her in March 2017 with no disclosures.
